When will this happen? From 6.00pm Tuesday 19 September 2023 to 3.30pm on Thursday 21 September 2023

Who is invited? Pastors, church leaders, Christian organisation leaders, Christian leaders from different denominations, generations and cultures

Giving thanks for Pray As One this year:

reflections by Andrew Marriott

It has been an honour to host a number of sessions over the past year, focusing on issues affecting our nation and informing our prayers as one in the body of Christ.

For our last session of 2022, we took time to reflect on the past year and give thanks to God for his faithfulness and answered prayer.

Hon Alfred Ngaro joined us and said he wants "to give thanks and honour to the Lord and thanks to Pray As One. An amazing platform that is uniting this nation, its intercessors and its people, to pray before the Lord." He said that the name itself declares the power of God's people coming together in unity, according to Psalm 133 - "It's not just about the words that are prayed ... it's the apostolic action that Pray As One provides as a platform, ...the seeking, the tarrying, the contending in the Spirit". Alfred also noted that a number from Pray As One have joined Intercessors Aotearoa on Wednesday nights, and shared some testimonies of answered prayer, especially through the two "72/72" prayer sessions .and that "we have seen a shift when we pray according to God's will, not ours".

Pona Solomona (Regional Manager Central Prison Chaplains Aotearoa) was so thankful for being prayed for. It opened the door for an interview with Radio

Rhema, opportunities to share in churches and he is really encouraged personally.

David & Dale Garratt (Scripture in Song) wrote: "PAONZ is so very significant for our nation. We have been privileged to take part this year and have had friends, as well, who have had wonderful answers to prayer from the 'breakouts'. Andrew has done a masterful job of guiding everyone involved to participate and experience the anointing of the Holy Spirit as they pray. If only this kind of meeting was taking place all over New Zealand, we would see our land healed and blessed. With our love David and Dale"



Family Camp - Easter Weekend


6-10 April - MiCamp Taupo
