

# Christians and parliament, parties, and voting

**OPINION PIECE** 

In a pluralistic society such as New Zealand, we can always expect a wide range of different worldviews to be evident in Parliament. But Christians should definitely be part of the mix. We need capable Christian MPs in as many different parties as possible, people who are able to be both excellent MPs and faithful Christians, in any part of the political spectrum. There are some parties where the Christian presence needs to be strengthened, and some where it may need to be established.

Politics is a highly demanding and complicated environment. Those Christian MPs who are already in Parliament very much need our support, especially in prayer.

Christians who are worthy candidates in the upcoming election may also need us to vote for them.

Since the introduction of MMP, in 1996, there has also been a slight possibility of so-called "Christian" parties getting into Parliament. There have been many such Christian-values or Christian-friendly parties, including some current contenders.

When Christian Heritage and the Christian Democrats campaigned as a coalition in 1996, they together polled 4.33% of the party vote. The only time a Christian-values party has reached the 5% threshold was in 2002 and 2005, when Future New Zealand joined with the United Party, whose leader Peter

Dunne held an electorate seat; their 6.7% polling in 2002 resulted in an additional seven Christians entering Parliament (reducing to two in 2005, and none from 2008).

All this suggests that Christian-values parties face an extremely steep challenge to get into Parliament, that those who work with others may do better, and that parties with a centrist stance may possibly do best.

As Christians, we should not see politics as the primary answer to New Zealand's problems, and we should avoid confusing or compromising the Gospel with worldly political ideologies. But with prayerful and careful voting, let's do what can do to strengthen an appropriate Christian presence and voice in our Parliament.


