

Kia ora tatou,

Pray for Israeli and Palestinian people, and against bitterness, enmity, and bloodshed

Many Christian and Jewish people – though not all – see the modern reestablishment of Israel as an extraordinary divine fulfillment of biblical prophecies, and as a prelude to momentous end-time events still to come.

However, many Arab and Muslim people, and secular people, do not see it that way.

Unquestionably, the recent terrorist attacks on Israeli people by Hamas fighters were brutal and evil. The attacks reflected Palestinian bitterness about decades of conflict, and a rejection – by some – of the very existence of Israel. Morally, though, such a massacre can never be justified.

The decision of Israel to invade Gaza and destroy Hamas is understandable, but fraught with considerable danger. Such an incursion will inevitably lead to a huge loss of life. Many have already died, and – whatever the rights or wrongs – Palestinian and international Muslim outrage will only be compounded.

So how might we pray?

- Pray for those on both sides who mourn, or who are wounded, or homeless, or who now live in great fear
- Pray for the vulnerable minority of Palestinians who are Christian
- Pray for water, food, power and medical supplies and major humanitarian aid to be freely available to Gaza
- Pray for inspired and gifted peacemakers, for a general de-escalation, for a ceasefire, and for a negotiated settlement

- Pray for a deeper miracle: for a new desire among both Jews and Arabs to live alongside each other not in hatred and violence, but with generosity, justice, mercy, and respect
- Pray that large numbers of Jews and Palestinians may come to believe in Christ, and so find peace with God and a growing peace with others
- Pray for God's sovereign purposes to be fulfilled, across the world, and that God's Kingdom may come.

Pray for our incoming Government, and for all new MPs

All governments do some things well, and other things not so well. In democracies, lots of voters sooner or later become disappointed with every successive government, the old government is swept from office, and a jubilant new government takes its place. Last week, this pattern has once again played out.

As Christians, we need to uphold our new National-led government in prayer, that it might govern justly and wisely, and for the wellbeing of all.

We can pray for all members of Parliament, and at this time especially for our new MPs.

Pray that Christian MPs in every party may be people of grace, humility, and courage, who in all matters speak and act in a way that commends Christian faith and values and which transcends political divides.

The outgoing Parliament was arguably the most socially liberal one that New Zealand has ever had, with a majority of MPs from across the political spectrum supporting radical legislation in such areas as euthanasia, abortion, and samesex and transgender identity. Will the new Parliament continue those trends? Or will there be more of those – Christian and otherwise – who discern such issues deeply, stand firm against the powerful ideological pressures of this time, and can persuasively speak up for truth and traditional ethics within the very pluralistic context that is Parliament? Let's pray for that.


